Dear students & families,
This week we wrapped up our intensive 8-week Bullystoppers program. Naranga students have participated in a range of classroom and whole school anti-bullying activities. The activities are intended to give students the skills to stop bullying in its tracks and to help build a supportive school community. Key concepts covered in the lessons included encouragement and skill development for all students, and especially bystanders, to respond to bullying behaviour and support students who are bullied. Preventing bullying involves the whole school, and students have an important part to play. I have been very impressed with the quality of anti-bullying posters designed by some of the older students in the school. All members of the school community contributed to the outstanding display in the school foyer. It reinforces the message **We Stand Together to Beat Bullying**. These efforts are just a small part of promoting a positive school environment that provides safety, security and support for students, and promotes positive relationships and student wellbeing.
