## *Educational purpose of the program:*

Students will participate in camp activities that meet the following Victorian Curriculum personal and social capabilities criteria:

- Identify personal strengths and describe how these strengths are useful in school or family life
- Explain how being prepared to try new things can help identify strategies when faced with unfamiliar or challenging situations
- Use basic skills required for participation in group tasks and respond to simple questions about their contribution to group tasks
- Listen to others' ideas, and recognise that others may see things differently
- Identify the characteristics of an effective team and develop descriptions for particular roles including leadership, and describe both their own and their team's performance when undertaking various roles
- Participate positively in groups and teams by encouraging others and negotiating roles and responsibilities
- Apply critical and creative thinking processes in order to generate and assess solutions to movement challenges
- Demonstrate ethical behaviour and fair play that aligns with the rules when participating in a range of physical activities

## *Student behaviour*

'I understand that in the event of my child's misbehaviour or behaviour that poses a danger to himself/herself or others during the excursion, he/she may be sent home. I further understand that in such circumstances I will be informed and that any costs associated with his/her return will be my responsibility.'

## *Student illness*

'I understand that in the event excursion staff determine it is necessary for my child to be sent home early due to illness, any cost associated with his/her return will be my responsibility.'

*Photograph consent*

'I also consent to my child being photographed and/or visual images of my child being taken during activities by the school for use in the school's publications, school's website or for publicity purposes without acknowledgment and without being entitled to any remuneration or compensation.' *Cancellations or Alterations*

'I understand that the principal may need to cancel or alter excursion arrangements at short notice, due to circumstances beyond the control of the school, and while the principal will try to minimise inconvenience or financial losses to parents, these may be unavoidable.'

*Consent for emergency transportation*

'In the event of an emergency I consent to my child being transported in a privately owned vehicle driven by a member of the supervisory staff listed above.'

*Student accident insurance*

The Department of Education does not provide student accident cover. Parents may wish to obtain student accident insurance cover from a commercial insurer, depending on their health insurance arrangements and any other personal considerations.
