Principal's Report

Dear students & families,

Since the start of term 3, Naranga staff have been giving students Commendation Cards. Students receive a Commendation Card when they are witnessed demonstrating one of our key expectations in an outstanding manner. They can receive a card for being responsible, being safe, being respectful and being a learner.

You would be aware that Naranga School uses the School-Wide Positive Behaviour Support framework. SWPBS supports positive behaviours and uses evidence-based behavioural interventions to enhance academic and social behaviour outcomes for all students. Naranga has been implementing SWPBS since 2012.

Students receive feedback on their academic performance as a matter of routine in schools. At Naranga we also explicitly teach pro-social behaviours and rewards students for displaying them. Programs such as our SWPBS Raffle, Senior Commendations, Friendship Cup, and now, the Commendation Cards are intended to provide students with feedback on their social skills and behaviour.

Please ask your son or daughter tonight if they've received a commendation in the past month. Also ask them why they received the commendation. As usual, the SWPBS News page in this newsletter includes a list of students who have received awards in the past fortnight. Awards are presented at our weekly whole school Assembly on Wednesdays at 9am. Parents and friends are always welcome to attend the Assembly. Hope to see you there next week.
