Dear Parents and Guardians

The *Education and Training Reform Act 2006* ensures that instruction in the standard curriculum learning areas is to be provided to students in Government Schools free of charge. The Act enables School Councils to charge fees for items and services to support the delivery of this free instruction. The Naranga School Council is responsible for developing and approving the parent payment.

The Naranga School Council has set the cost of Essential Student Learning Items at **\$220** per child for 2021.

Families may choose to pay **\$200** (saving **\$20**) per child by making an early payment by **Friday 19th February 2021**. Fees may also be paid in quarterly instalments throughout the year or by private arrangement with the Principal.

The School Council seeks your support for the development of programs that support our students by urging you to promptly pay the **Essential Student Learning Items** component of the items and services fees. The breakdown of how your money is distributed to support your child is provided on the next page.

School Council has reinstated the **Voluntary Contribution** scheme for families who wish to contribute *an extra amount* to the school. Your Voluntary Contribution will assist in the development of our new Sensory Room. This room will provide students with a quiet space where they can engage in relaxing activities that will assist them to calm and self-regulate their emotions. Your donations will ensure that appropriate, effective and therapeutic equipment is purchased for this important service.

The Home Economics and Food Technology fee will again be invoiced separately for families whose students in the participate in these programs. The payment will be required prior to your child commencing this program, which provides consumables for all cooking programs.
