## Principal's Report

Dear students & families,  
We had the most fantastic Athletics Day yesterday – the students and staff excelled in their various races. A huge congratulations to **SAFE House**, who won the overall trophy.

At assembly yesterday we were very excited to announce our **School Captains**. Six Pathways students nominated for this very important role. They each gave a speech to us at assembly last week telling the school community what they would do to help the school be the best it can be. All the students and teachers then voted for their two favourite candidates.
