School Holiday Program Jan 2019

- Programs & support are designed for people with disabilities who require a standard level of support of 1 carer to 3 participants.
- The activities are generally 5-6 hours in total including pick up (9-10am) and drop off (3-4pm)
- All transport, support, admission & activities costs are included as well as lunch where specified
- Pick ups are in the Frankston, Mornington Peninsula, Kingston or Casey areas, referrals may be accepted.
- The cost is based on the support ratio of 1 support worker per 3 participants-\$250 plus GST. NDIS participants can use 'Core Support' funding
- All activities are suitable for ages 6 years to young adults
- Registration of interest must be received before activity dates can be confirmed. 'First Time' participants must provide a support profile before registration can be finalised, confirming the level of support that is required for the participant.
- Registration closes on Monday 10th December
- Participants will be sent a booking confirmation via email by Friday 21st Dec.
- Fees are payable in full once activity dates are confirmed
